Q1. How do I register for the Job Fair?

Registration for the job fair will occur on-site. Please bring a hardcopy of your resume to drop off with the registration table prior to entering the exhibit hall.

Q2. Do I need to register for the 2019 CISA National Cybersecurity Summit to attend the job fair?

No. The job fair is free and open to the public.

Q3. How can I receive a job offer on-the-spot?

Candidates will have the opportunity to speak with hiring managers and, if qualified, interview for positions during the fair. Please make sure to bring your resume and all applicable employment eligibility documents identified above. For some positions, candidates may be asked to apply to job postings on USAJOBS.

Q4. What happens if I receive an offer during the event?

Staff will assist you in beginning the pre-employment process on-site.

Q5. Are there opportunities for student internships?

CISA's internship announcements will be posted on www.usajobs.gov soon. Candidates interested in internship opportunities must apply online through the upcoming vacancy announcements.

Q7. How do I apply through USAJOBS?

Create your account on www.usajobs.gov; upload your resume and supporting documents, as requested in the announcement. Click the "Apply" button on the announcement, attach your resume and documents, answer the assessment questions. You may also be directed to submit a longer USAHire Assessment.
